Blessing Box – Pop top meals, breakfast bars, fruit cups and hygiene items.

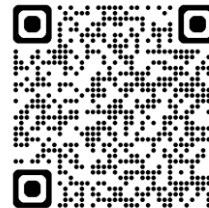
